TRAVELING OZ

Two film-makers have been mesmerized by Tropical North Queensland. The filming they described as "incredible footage" will be seen on the ABC in April and in 95 other countries through Travel Channel Europe, the largest pan-European TV channel.

"Tourism Tropical North Queensland hosts around 200 media representatives annually" say TTNQ Chief Executive Officer Rob Giason. "It's an investment by TTNQ and our members in generating stories in newspapers and magazines and on radio, internet and TV around the world. These stories have the power to motivate travelers to choose Tropical North Queensland for their holiday."

TTNQ and its members hosted presenter and cameraman, Tim Doyle and Tim Charody, better known as the "Two Tims" from the ABC television show Travel Oz to shoot three series segments around Tropical North Queensland during November. They spent nine action-packed days experiencing adventures in Port Douglas, Cairns Highlands, Mossman, Daintree, Cape Tribulation, Mission Beach, Green Island and Cairns.

"We had such a sensational time and scored some incredible footage" says Tim Doyle. "There were so many highlights everything was great!"

The "Two Tims" segments will also be telecast on The Australia Network, Australia's international satellite channel, operated by the ABC, and currently available in 10.2 million homes in 41 countries across Asia and the Pacific.
